Students explore a range of environmental issues, including climate change, marine pollution, deforestation, overconsumption, and other related topics while analyzing their direct consequences in the US.

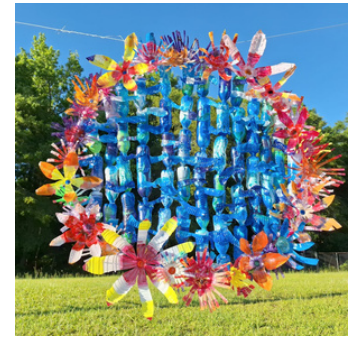

WORKSHOP FEES

Workshop fees per hour including workshop preparation, delivery art supplies and presence of two MicroPlasticsJO instructors range between \$175 & \$475.

Fees vary based on the number of participants, total number of hours, project complexity and the art supplies required.

WORKSHOP DURATION

Workshops can last from one hour to several weeks based on the desired format and content.
